



# HRVATSKA ZAJEDNICA HERCEG-BOSNA HRVATSKO VIJEĆE OBRANE

U ovom gradu, u skladu sa strukture parlamentarne vlasti, postoje su tužnu pripremu pisaniva za rat, čija se neminovnost može predviđati. Bojne i ratne propusti karakterišu rad te vlasti u obliku mogućanja. Danje robnih i materijalnih rezervi, zaštita i osiguranje vilaubih, gospodarskih i infrastrukturnih objekata grada (PTT, bolnice, sudovi, SDK, MUP, školski i univerzitetski objekti, kulturna i umjetnička baština, arhivsko-knjižnički fondus, sakralni i spomenički objekti), stanje objekata i prostora i njihova funkcionalnost, osiguranje alternativnih pravaca vodoopskrbe, prenosa i distribucije električne energije, te slanje drugih energenata, sve do gotovo blagonaklonog progatranja razmještaja srbo-crnogorskog rezervnog sastava bivše JNA na strateški važnima iznad grada odakle se i danas bestijalno i sistemski lakura.

Iz te a lakve strukture parlamentarne vlasti oformljen je Krizni štab općine, od pojedinaca koji svojim radom u miru ne predstavljaju garanta uspješnog djelovanja u ratu, što su ovaj grad i njegova okolica na pofragičniji način osjetili. S tim u vazi Hrvatsko vijeće obrane - Općinski stožer Mostar u povjerenoj mu funkciji branitelja ovog grada na svojoj redovitoj sjednici od 15. svibnja 1992. godine donio je:

## NAREDBU

1. Raspušta se Krizni štab općine Mostar čime prestaju sve njegove ingerencije u uložni predstavnika civilne vlasti.
2. U svezi sa prvom tačkom ove naredbe Hrvatsko vijeće obrane - Općinski stožer Mostar formiraće civilnu ratnu vladu
3. U ob formiranja vlade iz tačke dva ove naredbe kompletno funkcioniranje grada i brigu o njegovim žiteljima obavljat će Vijeće za posebne namjene Hrvatskog vijeća obrane - Općinskog stožera Mostar.
4. Ova naredba stupila je na snagu dana 15. svibnja 1992. godine.

It was from this kind of parliamentary authority that the municipality Crisis Staff was formed, of individuals whose work in peace time provided no guarantee that they would make a success of it in war, which the city and its surroundings felt in the most tragic way possible. In connection with that, the Mostar Municipal Staff of the

Croatian Defence Council, in accordance with the task assigned to it to defend the municipality, at its regular session on 15 May 1992 issues the following

ORDER

1. The Crisis Staff of the municipality of Mostar shall be disbanded; therefore, all its responsibilities as the representative of civilian authority shall cease.
2. In connection with paragraph 1 of this order, the Mostar Municipal Staff of the Croatian Defence Council shall form a civilian wartime government.
3. Until the government referred to in paragraph 2 of this order is formed, the Special Purpose Council of the Mostar Municipal Staff of the Croatian Defence Council shall administer the entire functioning of the city and care for its citizens.
4. This order entered into force on 15 May 1992.
